

ROW SEATING ARRANGEMENT

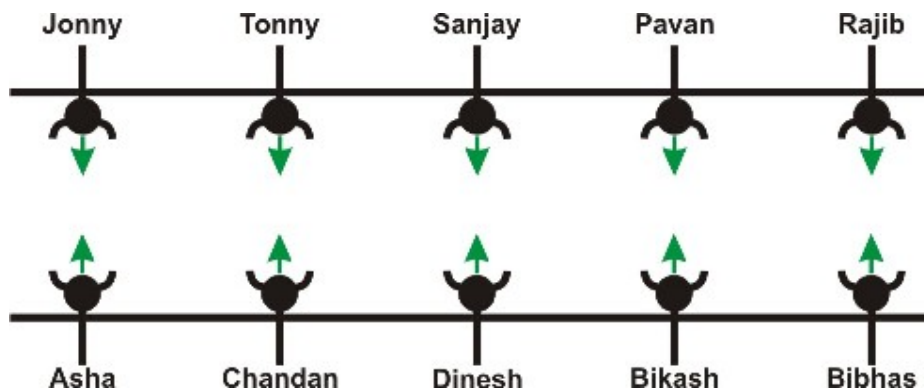

- Bikash is opposite to Pavan, who is next right of Bibhas.
- Rajib is at one end of line.
- Sanjay sits opposite of Dinesh.
- Jonny sits immediate right of Tonny.

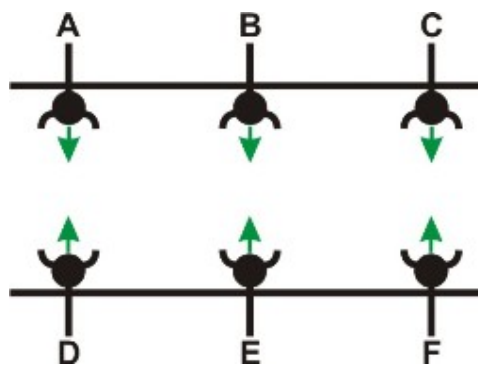

- C is immediate left of B, who is facing E.
