

Absorption of Digested Food, Waste Food in Large Intestine



When the process of digestion is completed, the food is converted into a simple liquid and is ready to be absorbed from the walls of the small intestine. From there the blood moves it to all the cells of the body.

After the nutrition from the food is absorbed the remaining food material is converted into waste product. This waste product from the large intestine moves to the rectum and from rectum it is finally excreted outside the body through the anus.
