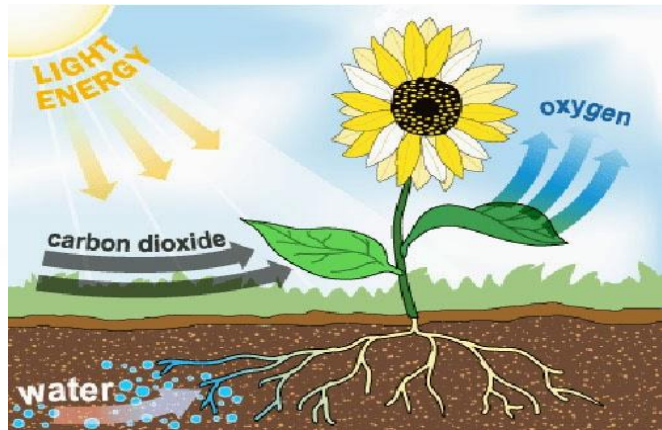


## How do Plants Use Food?



Plants make their food in their leaves. The leaves contain a pigment called chlorophyll, which color the leaves green. Food prepared by the leaves is called starch and it is a kind of sugar. This starch is used by the plants to produce new cells and to repair the old ones.
