Animals are found in all places or habitats. Some places such as deserts are very hot and dry and other places have very little water. Not all animals can survive in all places. Camels can live in deserts but they cannot survive in cold places. Similarly fish can live only in water and not on land. Animals can live in many different places because they have special features to survive in the area they live in. The surroundings or the environment in which an animal or a plant lives is called its habitat.
