

Frogs



Female frog lays hundreds of eggs at a time in a lake or pond. The eggs lie in a jelly like mass. These large clusters of eggs are called spawns. Tiny tadpoles hatch out of the egg. They swim in water and look like fishes. A tadpole starts to grow legs after a few weeks. They have gills for breathing under water. After a few weeks the lungs and legs start growing in the tadpoles. The tails of the tadpoles become shorter and shorter and finally disappear as they grow bigger and bigger and finally become adult frog.

The parent birds feed and protect the young birds until they can look after themselves.
