

Calendar



A Calendar is a chart or series of pages showing the days, weeks and months of a particular year, or giving particular seasonal information.

We know that a calendar have 12 months. Some months have 30 days and some have 31 days.

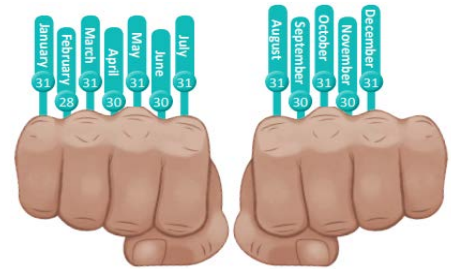
- January, March, May, July, August, October and December have 31 days.
- April, June, September and November have 30 days.
- February has 28 days. In a leap year it has 29 days.

While calculating days, we need to remember the number of days present in the particular months.



Do you feel any problem to remember the number of days there are in a month? **Here is a trick.**

- Fold your hands as shown.
- All the knuckles show the month with 31 days.
- The others (except February) have 30 days.



Let us understand with some examples:

Example 1: How many days are there between 20th March and 28th April?

Solution: March has 31 days and April has 30 days.

So, 20th March to 31st March = $31 - 20 = 11$ days

And, 1st April to 28th April = 28 days

Total number of days between 20th march and 28th April

= $11 + 28 = 39$ days

Example 2: Indian premier league (IPL) – 2019 started on 7th September 2019 and ended on 27th October 2019. For how many days did the competition continue?

Solution: September has 30 days and October has 31 days.

So, 7th September to 30th September = $30 - 6 = 24$ days

1st October to 27th October = 27 days

Total number of days = $24 + 27 = 51$ days

Thus, the IPL continued for 51 days.
