## **Understanding the Topic**

- We can use different coins and notes to make the same amount of money.
- This helps us when we **pay for things** in shops.
- We can add different rupees and paise to make a total.
- For example, to make ₹10, we can use one ₹10 note or two ₹5 coins.

## How to make up the Amount

- Use **addition** to make the total amount.
- We can use **₹1**, **₹2**, **₹5**, **₹10** coins or **₹10**, **₹20**, **₹50**, **₹100** notes.
- The total should be equal to the given amount.

## **Examples with Solutions**

1. Make ₹5 using ₹2 and ₹1 coins

**Answer:** ₹2 + ₹2 + ₹1 = ₹5

2. Make ₹10 using ₹5 coins

**Answer:** ₹5 + ₹5 = ₹10

3. Make ₹7 using ₹2 and ₹1 coins

**Answer:** ₹2 + ₹2 + ₹2 + ₹1 = ₹7

4. Make ₹15 using ₹10 and ₹5

**Answer:** ₹10 + ₹5 = ₹15

5. Make ₹20 using ₹10 and ₹2 coins

**Answer:** ₹10 + ₹2 + ₹2 + ₹2 + ₹2 + ₹2 = ₹20

## **Summary Points**
