



Make up the Amount

Understanding the Topic

- We can use different **coins** and **notes** to make the same **amount of money**.
- This helps us when we **pay for things** in shops.
- We can **add different rupees and paise** to make a total.
- For example, to make ₹10, we can use one ₹10 note or two ₹5 coins.

How to make up the Amount

- Use **addition** to make the total amount.
- We can use **₹1, ₹2, ₹5, ₹10** coins or **₹10, ₹20, ₹50, ₹100** notes.
- The total should be **equal to the given amount**.

Examples with Solutions

1. Make ₹5 using ₹2 and ₹1 coins

Answer: $₹2 + ₹2 + ₹1 = ₹5$

2. Make ₹10 using ₹5 coins

Answer: $₹5 + ₹5 = ₹10$

3. Make ₹7 using ₹2 and ₹1 coins

Answer: $₹2 + ₹2 + ₹2 + ₹1 = ₹7$

4. Make ₹15 using ₹10 and ₹5

Answer: $₹10 + ₹5 = ₹15$

5. Make ₹20 using ₹10 and ₹2 coins

Answer: $₹10 + ₹2 + ₹2 + ₹2 + ₹2 + ₹2 = ₹20$

Summary Points

- We can use **different coins and notes** to make the same amount.
- Use **addition** to match the total.
- There is more than **one way** to make the same amount.
- This helps us **pay correctly** using the money we have.
