
One-Fourth (or A Quarter)

One - Fourth (or A Quarter)

A fraction is a part of a whole. One-fourth means the whole is divided into 4 equal parts, and we take 1 part. It is also called a quarter. We write it as ¼ (read as "one-fourth" or "a quarter"). 4 quarters make 1 whole.

Where Do We Use One-Fourth?

- When we cut a thing into 4 equal parts.
- When we share among 4 people.
- When we take or color 1 out of 4 equal parts.



Examples with Solutions

1. Q: A circle is divided into 4 equal parts. 1 part is shaded. What is shaded?

Answer: One-fourth $(\frac{1}{4})$

2. Q: You cut a sandwich into 4 equal pieces and eat 1. How much did you eat?

Answer: One-fourth (1/4)

3. Q: A chocolate is shared among 4 kids. What part does each get?

Answer: One-fourth $(\frac{1}{4})$

4. Q: A rectangle is divided into 4 equal parts. 2 parts are colored. What part is colored?

Answer: 2 out of $4 = \frac{2}{4}$

5. Q: A pizza has 4 slices. Riya eats 1 slice. What part of the pizza did she eat?

Answer: One-fourth $(\frac{1}{4})$

Summary Points

- 4 one-fo
 - 4 one-fourths make 1 whole
 - Used when things are divided into 4 equal parts
