## The Sentence

#### **Definition of a Sentence**

• A sentence is a group of words that makes complete sense.

**Example:** Rohit is a good batsman.

## **Nonsensical Groups**

• Group of words like "morning is it a lovely" do not make sense. Hence, not sentences.

#### **Characteristics of a Sentence**

- Begins with a capital letter.
- Ends with a full stop (.), question mark (?), or exclamation mark (!).
- Number of words can vary, but it must convey complete meaning.

## **Types of Sentences**

# 1. Declarative or Statement Sentences

- They state facts or ideas.
- End with a full stop (.)

#### **Examples:**

- She is my sister.
- The sun rises in the east.

#### 2. Interrogative Sentences

- They ask questions.
- End with a question mark (?)

#### **Examples:**

- O Where is my book?
- o Do you like chocolate?

## 3. Imperative Sentences

- They give orders, requests, or advice.
- End with a full stop (.)

#### **Examples:**

- Please sit down.
- O Do not touch that wire!

## **4. Exclamatory Sentences**

- They express strong feelings or emotions.
- End with an exclamation mark (!)

#### **Examples:**

- O What a beautiful house!
- O How wonderful the view is!
