# **Punctuation Marks**

#### **Introduction to Punctuation**

Punctuation marks are symbols used in writing to help make the meaning of sentences clear and readable. Without them, communication in written form becomes confusing or misleading.

#### Why Punctuation is Important

- Clarifies the meaning of sentences
- Helps structure writing
- Adds expression and emotion
- Avoids ambiguity and misinterpretation

#### **Common Punctuation Marks & Their Usage**

## 1. Full Stop (.)

• Used at the end of declarative (telling) sentences.

**Example:** My name is Raunak.

o Also used in abbreviations (e.g., M.A., M.P., U.S.A.).

# 2. Question Mark (?)

• Used at the end of a question (interrogative sentence).

**Example:** What is your name?

### 3. Exclamation Mark (!)

Shows strong or sudden feelings like joy, anger, surprise, etc.

**Example:** Hurrah! We have won the match.

# 4. Comma (,)

#### **Used for:**

- Listing items: I bought pens, pencils, and crayons.
- **Separating dialogue:** He said, "It is raining."
- Addressing someone: Meera, come here.
- Question tags: You are fine, aren't you?

#### **5. Capital Letter**

#### **Used for:**

- Beginning of every sentence: She is a good girl.
- Proper nouns: India, Rahul, Delhi.
- The pronoun 'I': I like to read.
- Each line of a poem.

## 6. Quotation Marks ("")

• Encloses direct speech or quotations.

Example: She said, "I am happy."

# 7. Apostrophe (')

- Shows possession: Rani's book, Rahul's car.
- Shows contraction (omitted letters):
  - $\circ$  I am  $\rightarrow$  I'm
  - $\circ$  He is  $\rightarrow$  He's
  - Cannot → Can't
