

About Drought



- A. Drought refers to the shortage of rain or no rainfall in a particular area or region for longer time.
- B. Sometimes very hot drought temperature, dry hot wind and other tough climatic conditions are also considered as droughts.
- C. It also leads to unbalanced environment.
- D. Drought affected regions usually suffer from famines.
- E. Many agencies and helping organizations bring aids to these affected areas like food, medicines, and drinking water.
- F. India suffered three major droughts — in 1904-05, 1965-66 and 1986-87.
