- A. Kharif crops are grown with the start of monsoon in different parts of the country.
  - B. These are harvested in September-October.
  - C. Kharif crops are planted in the early rainy season or in the autumn.
  - D. Example of Kharif crops are rice, jowar, millets and maize.

## **Rabi Crops**

- A. Rabi crops are sown at the end of the monsoon or at the beginning of winter.
  - B. They are also known as winter crops.
  - C. Flowering requires a day long length.
  - D. The harvesting season of Rabi crops is spring.
  - E. Wheat, gram etc. are Rabi crops.
  - F. Farmers use pesticides to protect their crop from insects and pests.
