- B. These are harvested in September-October.
- C. Kharif crops are planted in the early rainy season or in the autumn.
- D. Example of Kharif crops are **rice, jowar, millets and maize**.

Rabi Crops

- ➡ A. Rabi crops are sown at the end of the monsoon or at the beginning of winter.
- B. They are also known as winter crops.
- C. Flowering requires a day long length.
- D. The harvesting season of Rabi crops is spring.
- E. Wheat, gram etc. are Rabi crops.
- F. Farmers use pesticides to protect their crop from insects and pests.
