
## Seeds



Seeds are in fruits so that new plants grow from seeds. Let's learn parts of seeds.



A. Seed contains a miniature plant, called an embryo.

- B. That can develop into a fully grown plant.
- C. The outer shell of a seed, called a seed coat.
- D. It protects the embryo.
- E. Inside the seed a nutritious material provides food to the embryo.
- F. In flowering plants this material is called endosperm.
- G. It contains the fleshy seed leaves and baby plant inside it.

All seeds do not produce new plants. Some seeds separate from the mother plant undeveloped.

Some are eaten by birds and animals or destroyed by the rain and wind. They do not get proper condition for development.
