

Symmetry in 3D Shapes



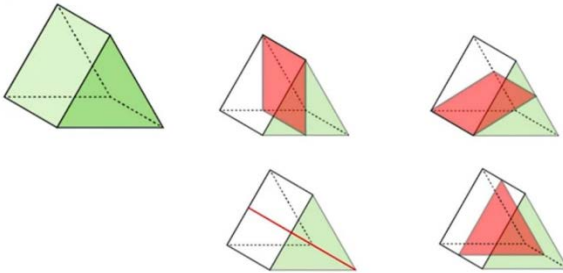
A plane of symmetry bisects a shape into halves that are mirror images of each other.
