



# CONCEPT GAP ANALYZER



Concept gaps refer to the areas of knowledge where individuals have limited or incomplete information.



Concept gaps provide a starting point for acquiring new knowledge, expanding perspectives, and developing a deeper understanding of the subject matter.




- Stimulate curiosity and learning
- Promote critical thinking and problem-solving
- Improve communication

Gap analyzer is a report which shows the lacking of learning of the student.

To check the Concept Gap follow the steps:

1. Click on the gap analyzer button from the particular class pie chart. Two option will appear. (Refer figure 1)



2. To check the Concept Gap, click on the concept gap button, page will appear. (Refer Figure 2)



3. To check the details, Click on particular concept whose report we want to see. Page will appear (Refer Figure 3)



4. To check the Detailed Task report click on any student. Page will appear (Refer figure 4)


