International Number Numeration

The International numeral system is the most commonly used in the world. The International numeral system uses separators (commas) differently from the Indian norm. Instead of grouping the rightmost three digits (until the hundreds place), and after that group by sets of two digits as in the Indian system, the International system groups digits by threes.

Let's see how to Read and Writing Numbers in the International Number System

In the International system, after the ten thousands place, we have hundred thousands, millions, ten millions, hundred millions, billions, and so on; there are new words for after third place. The following figure shows how to read and write the number name for 85419723, with the help of the International place value chart.



Read 85,419,723 as: Eighty five million, four hundred nineteen thousand, seven hundred twenty three.

Let's see some examples:-

A. 815,253,631 – Eight hundred fifteen million two hundred fifty-three thousand six hundred thirty-one.

B. 925,454,723 – Nine hundred twenty-five million four hundred fifty-four thousand seven hundred twenty- three.
