Excretion in Animals

- The process of removing toxic wastes from the body is called excretion. The organs involved in the process of excretion are called excretory organs.
- These organs are collectively called excretory system.



The body wastes are of three types:

Type of body waste	Specific waste	System involved in excretion
Gaseous waste	Carbon dioxide, water vapour	Respiratory system
Liquid waste	Urine, sweat, (containing salts, urea, etc.)	Excretory system
Solid waste	Faeces	Digestive system
