Numbers and Numerals

Understanding the Topic

Numbers are written in words. Numerals are written in digits. Every number word has a matching numeral. We use place value (hundreds, tens, and ones) to write numerals. Knowing both numbers and numerals helps us read, write, and understand numbers correctly

How to Write Numbers and Numerals

Step 1: Read the number in words Step 2: Break it into hundreds, tens, and ones **Step 3:** Write the matching digits to form the numeral **Step 4:** Check the place value to make sure it is correct **Examples with Solutions** Example 1: Number: One hundred twenty Solution: 120 Answer: Numeral is 120 Example 2: Number: Two hundred thirty-five Solution: 235 Answer: Numeral is 235 Example 3: Number: Four hundred eight Solution: 408 **Answer:** Numeral is 408 Example 4: Number: Seven hundred ninety Solution: 790 **Answer:** Numeral is 790 Example 5: Number: Nine hundred ninety-nine Solution: 999

Answer: Numeral is 999
