FLOWER - A FASCINATING ORGAN OF ANGIOSPERMS

• For ages, people have shared a close bond with flowers. Flowers hold significance in terms of beauty, decoration, social connections, religious practices, and cultural traditions.

• A flower typically has four parts arranged in circles. The outer parts, called calyx and corolla, are not crucial to the flower. The essential parts are Androecium and Gynoecium, and they play important roles in the flower's structure.




Fig.: A diagrammatic representation of L.S. of flower
