Day Time Sky

What is the Day Time Sky?

The sky we see during the day is called the daytime sky. It looks bright and blue because of sunlight.

What Do We See in the Day Time Sky?

The Sun

- The sun shines brightly in the sky.
- It gives us light and heat.
- The sun rises in the east and sets in the west.

Clouds

- Clouds are white or grey and float in the sky.
- Clouds bring rain.
- Sometimes they cover the sun.

Rainbow

- After rain, when the sunlight passes through water drops, we see a rainbow.
- A rainbow has 7 beautiful colours.

Birds and Aeroplanes

- We can see birds flying in the sky.
- We may also see aeroplanes flying high in the daytime sky.

Kites

• On windy days, children fly kites in the clear sky.
