Night Time Sky

What is the Night Time Sky?

The sky at night is called the night-time sky.

It looks dark because the sun has set.

What Do We See in the Night Time Sky?

The Moon

- The moon comes out at night.
- It shines with light from the sun.
- Sometimes it looks round (full moon) and sometimes half or thin.

Stars

- The stars twinkle in the night sky.
- They are tiny lights far away.
- There are millions of stars in the sky.

Planets and Shooting Stars

- Sometimes we can see planets that shine like stars.
- Shooting stars are quick flashes of light in the sky.

Owl and Bats

- Some animals like owls and bats come out at night.
- You might see them flying in the night sky.
