What is a Religion?

A religion is a way people pray, celebrate, and show their faith in God.

Different people follow different religions, and all religions teach us to be kind, honest, and loving.

Major Religions in India:

Hinduism

- People who follow Hinduism are called Hindus.
- They pray in a temple.
- Important festivals: Diwali, Holi, Dussehra.


Islam

- People who follow Islam are called Muslims.
- They pray in a mosque.
- Important festival: Eid.

Christianity

- People who follow Christianity are called Christians.
- They pray in a church.
- Important festival: Christmas.

Sikhism

- People who follow Sikhism are called Sikhs.
 - They pray in a Gurudwara.
 - Important festival: Gurupurab.
