Sources of Water

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Water comes from nature. These places where we get water from are called sources of water.

Natural Sources of Water:

i. Rain

- Main source of all water.
- Fills rivers, lakes, and ponds.

ii. Rivers

Flowing water that comes from mountains.

iii. Streams

• Small rivers with clean water.

iv. Lakes

• Big areas of water surrounded by land.

v. Seas and Oceans

• Very large water bodies, but the water is salty.

vi. Springs

• Water that comes out from the ground.

vii. Wells

Deep holes in the ground from which we draw water.

viii. Underground Water

Water found below the Earth that we get using hand pumps and borewells.

Man-made Sources of Water:

i. Taps

• We get water from taps at home, which is stored and cleaned.

ii. Tanks

• Store rainwater or supply water for villages and towns.

iii. Dams

• Big walls built to store river water.

Only a small amount of water on Earth is fit for drinking — so we must save water!
