Parts of Plant

What is a Plant?

A plant is a living thing that grows in the soil and needs sunlight, air, water, and nutrients to grow.

Root Part (Underground)

Roots grow under the soil.

Root	Functions
Roots hold the plant in the soil	Help the plant stand upright
Absorb water and minerals from the soil	Help the plant grow
Some roots store food	Examples: carrot, beetroot

Shoot Part (Above the ground)

This is the part that grows above the soil. It includes:

Part	Function
Stem	Holds the plant upright and carries water & food
Leaves	Make food for the plant using sunlight (photosynthesis)
Flowers	Help the plant make fruits and seeds
Fruits	Have seeds inside; grow from flowers
Buds	Grow into flowers
