Flowers

- Flowers are the reproductive part of a plant.
- They attract insects and birds for pollination.
- Flowers later grow into fruits and seeds.

Examples of Flowers:

- Rose
- Tulip
- Sunflower
- Lotus

Fruits

- Fruits grow from the flowers of plants.
- They usually contain seeds and help the plant make new plants.
- Fruits are eaten by humans and animals.

Examples of Fruits:

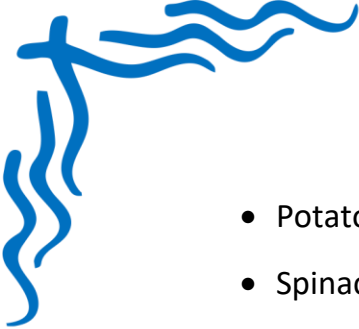
- Apple
- Banana
- Grapes
- Pineapple
- Peach

Vegetables

- Vegetables are parts of plants that we eat, such as roots, stems, leaves, or flowers.
- They are important for health and provide nutrients.

Examples of Vegetables:

- Carrot (root)



- Potato (root)
- Spinach (leaf)
- Corn (stem)
- Broccoli (flower)
