



## Conversion of Paise into Rupees

### Understanding Notes

- Paise is a smaller unit of Indian currency.
- 1 rupee = 100 paise
- To convert paise into rupees, we divide the paise by 100.

**Example:** 200 paise =  $200 \div 100 = ₹2$

- If the paise is not exactly 100 or 200, the answer will be in rupees with decimal.

**Example:** 150 paise =  $150 \div 100 = ₹1.50$

- Use ₹ symbol while writing the final answer in rupees.

### Example: (Easy – Exact rupee)

- Convert 300 paise into rupees
- $300 \div 100 = 3$

**Answer** = ₹3

### Example: (Easy – Exact rupee)

- Convert 500 paise into rupees
- $500 \div 100 = 5$

**Answer** = ₹5

### Example: (Moderate – Rupees with paise)

- Convert 275 paise into rupees
- $275 \div 100 = 2.75$

**Answer** = ₹2.75

### Example: (Moderate – Decimal conversion)

- Convert 125 paise into rupees
- $125 \div 100 = 1.25$

**Answer** = ₹1.25



### Example: (Moderate – Word problem)

- Ravi has 450 paise. How much money does he have in rupees?
- $450 \div 100 = 4.50$

**Answer** = ₹4.50

### Summary Points

- 1 rupee = 100 paise
  - Divide paise by 100 to convert into rupees.
  - The answer may be in whole rupees or rupees with decimal.
  - Always use ₹ symbol while writing the amount in rupees.
  - Converting paise into rupees makes money calculations simpler.
