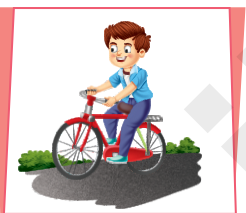
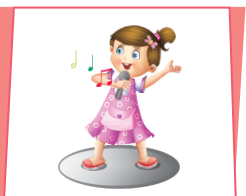

Doing Word tells us what someone or something does.

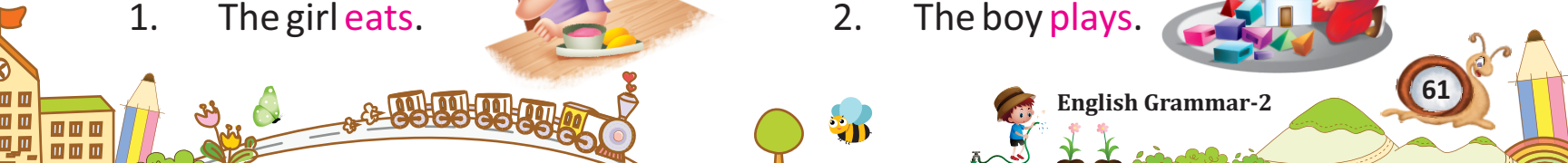
A doing word is also known as a **Verb** or **Action Word**.

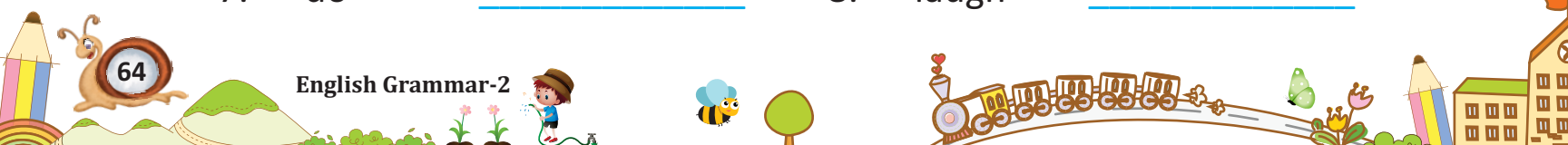
We use **-ing** words to talk about an action that is going on as we speak.

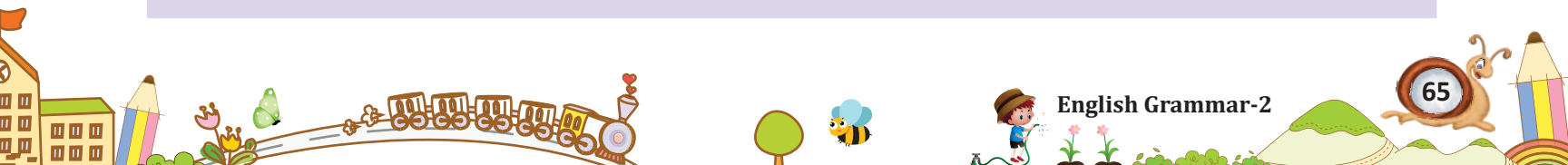
