- They will practice writing sentences using was and were.

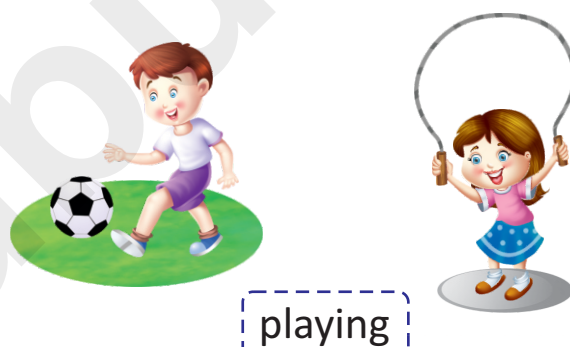

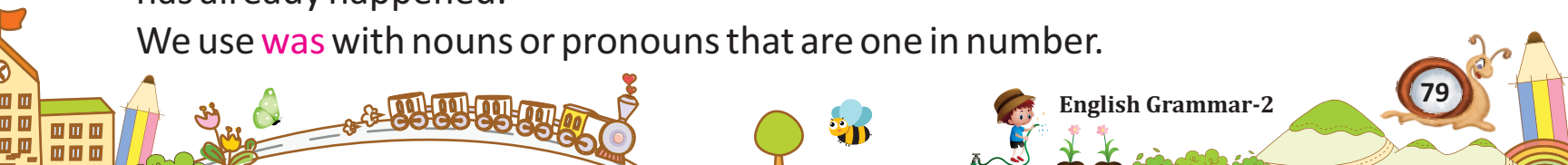

- ◉ We use **were** with 'you' or more than one noun or pronoun.

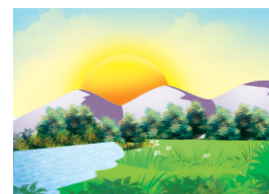
