## Nouns

Words that refer to the names of people, places, animals or things are called **Nouns**. All naming words are **Nouns**.

Look at the pictures and read the sentences.

1. The boy is reading.



2. The cat is sleeping.



3. Taj Mahal is in Agra.



4. It is a yellow bus.



In sentence 1, the word **boy** is the name of a person.

In sentence 2, the word **cat** is the name of an animal.

In sentence 3, **Taj Mahal** and **Agra** are the names of places.

In sentence 4, **bus** is the name of a thing.

### More Examples of Nouns :

**Persons** : boy, girl, father, mother, son, daughter, uncle, aunt, etc.

**Places** : home, school, temple, park, post office, etc.

**Things** : bat, ball, pen, balloon, book, pencil, etc.

**Animals** : elephant, tiger, dog, fox, lion, zebra, yak, etc.

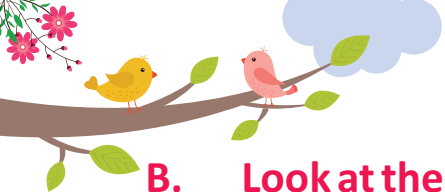
