Words that are used in place of naming words or nouns are called **Pronouns**.

Read these sentence.

- + This is Vishal.
- → Vishal is six years old.
- → Vishal likes painting.

In the above example, instead of repeating 'Vishal' in each sentence we can say:

This is Vishal. He is six years old. He likes painting.

Here in the place of noun Vishal, we have used the pronoun He.











- We use I in place of our own name.
- We use **You** for the person or persons we are speaking to.
- He is used in place of a male and She is used instead of a female.
- We is used to mean a group we are a part of.
- It is used for an animal or a thing.
- They is used for a group we are not a part of.


