



# Let's Start

### Using communication means





We often send messages to our friends and relatives.

Sending and receiving ideas, informa. on and messages is called communication.

Sources that we use to communicate are called **means of communication**. In earlier mes, messages were sent through men or through pigeons who would go from place to place to deliver the messages.



Now-a-days, we have faster and more convenient means of communicaon. Let us learn about some common means of communicaon.

### 1. Le. ers, postcards and envelopes

These are the most common means of communication. We can buy postcards, etc. from a post office. We write the message and close the letter in an envelope. We write the address of the person whom we are sending that letter to and paste a stamp on it. Then we put it in a letter box. Our letters are carried by trains, ships and aeroplanes to various places. They are delivered to the receivers by a postman.



### 2. Telephone:
