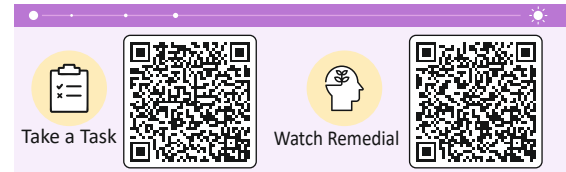

We need a house to live in. A house protects us from sunlight, heat, cold, rain, storm, thunder, wild animals, thieves, etc. It is not necessary that a house should be big to be called a good house. There are some features which make a house good. Without these features, a house is not suitable to live in.

FEATURES OF A GOOD HOUSE



1. A Good House Has Provision For Sunlight

A good house should have space on all sides. It must have doors and windows at proper places so that sunlight comes in at day time.

Sunlight is very important for us. It kills the germs that cause diseases to us. It makes a house warm and cheerful. This helps in keeping ourselves healthy.

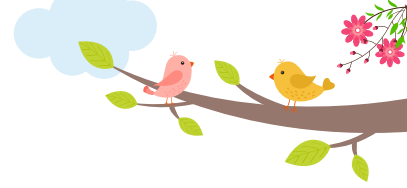

2. A Good House Has Provision For Ventilation And Windows

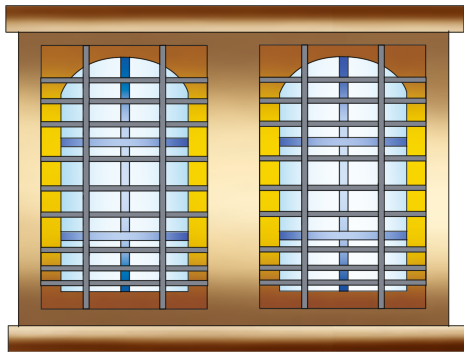
A good house must have windows and ventilators that allow fresh air to come in. A ventilator is an opening near the ceiling of the room. We should always take in fresh air. A house which has no provision for fresh air invites diseases.

A house must have **cross-ventilation** i.e. doors and windows of a house should face each other. It allows the air to pass through the house easily.

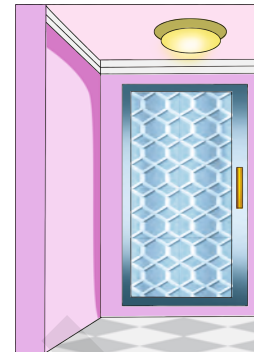


3. A Good House Has Provision For Grills And Wire Netting

The doors and windows should have proper grills and wire netting. These stop mosquitoes, flies, rats and lizards from entering our house.



Wire netting on window

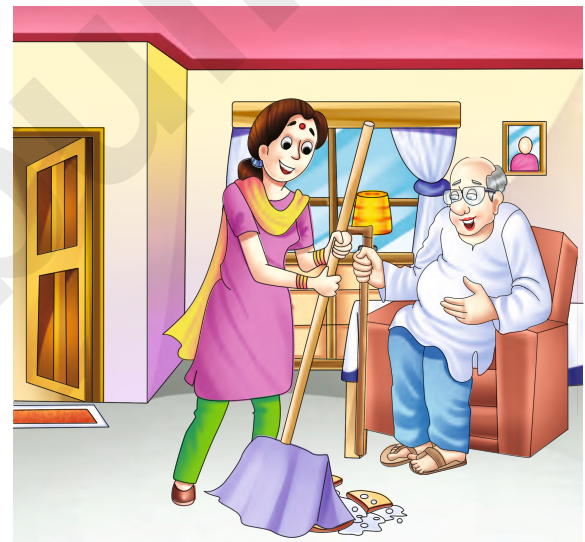


Wire netting on door

A CLEAN HOUSE

A good house must be very clean and dry. Things should be kept at proper places. The floor should be kept clean, swept and mopped daily. Garbage should be thrown in a dustbin. Furniture should be dusted daily.

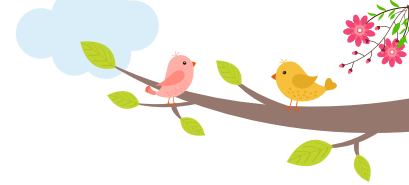

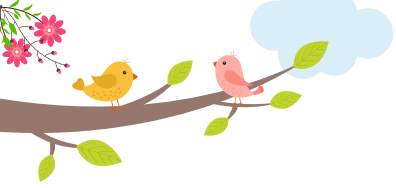
