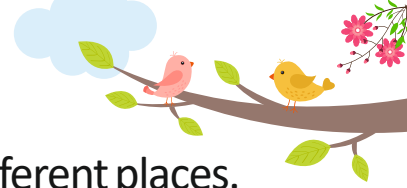

WILD ANIMALS

Some animals live in forests. They are called **wild** animals. Lion, tiger, giraffe, elephant, bear and fox are some of the wild animals. Some wild animals like elephant, lion, tiger etc. are big. Other animals like fox, monkey and squirrel are **small**.

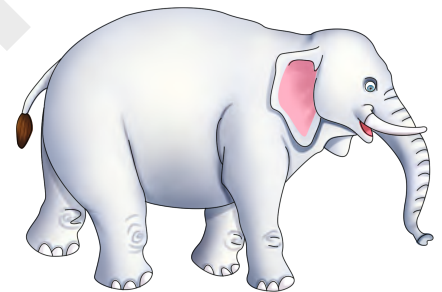

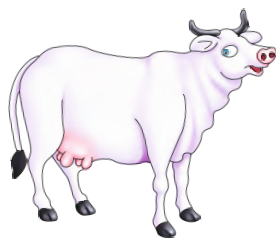

DOMESTIC ANIMALS

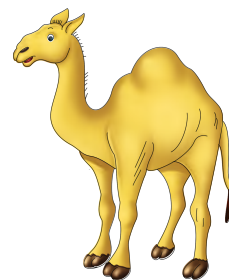
Some animals live with us in our houses or farms. They are called domestic animals. Like cow, buffalo, goat, horse, sheep, camel, pig, hen and duck are all domestic animals.



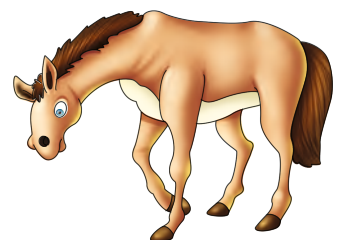

Domestic animals are very useful to us. Hens and ducks give us **eggs**. Cows, buffaloes and goats give us **milk**. Goat, hen and fish give us **meat**. Camel and horse carry our **loads**. Sheep and rabbit give us **wool**.

We keep some animals in our homes as our friends. They are called pet animals. Cat, dog, rabbit, fish and birds are some of the animals that we keep as our pets.

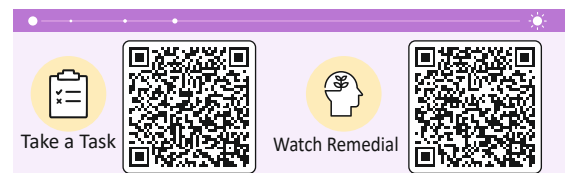

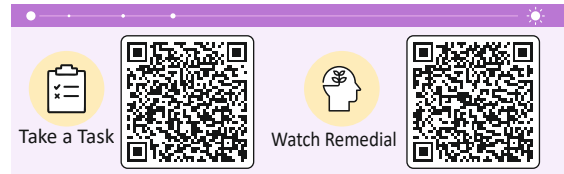


FOOD OF ANIMALS

Animals also need food to live and grow.

Different animals eat different kinds of food.

- Some animals like lion, tiger, wolf. etc. eat the **flesh** of other animals.
- Some animals like cow, buffalo, goat and horse eat only **plants** and **grass**.
- Some animals like sparrow, duck, hen and parrot eat **grains** and **insects**.



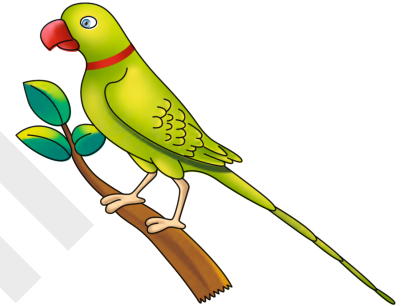

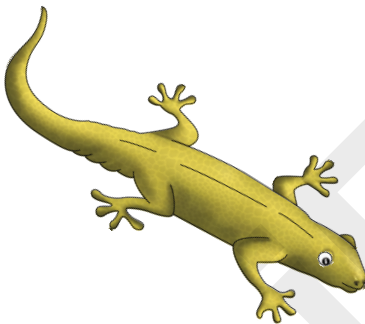

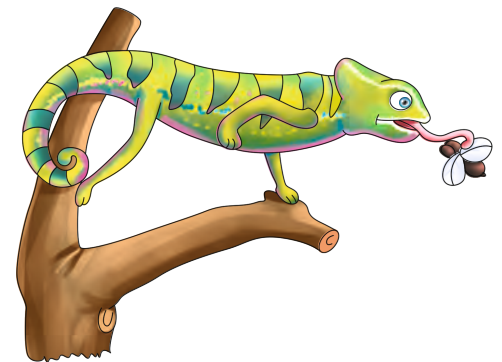
Some animals like lizards, spider and chameleon eat small **insects** and **worms**.
