Adjectives

Learning Outcomes

- Students will understand the definition and role of adjectives in sentences.
- They will identify different types of adjectives: descriptive, quantitative, demonstrative, and comparative.
- They will learn how to use adjectives to enhance writing and speaking.



Lead in

Create a poem using adjectives.

The teacher will give you one word like house. The students have to add as many descriptive words as possible and frame a poem.

Example : House

House is **big**.

House is **big** and **beautiful**.

House is **big**, **beautiful** and **pink**.

House is **pink**.

House is **pink** and **clean**.

House is my home.



Words that describe nouns or pronouns are called **adjectives**.

Examples : **Kind**, **good**, **red**, **two**, **fat**, etc.

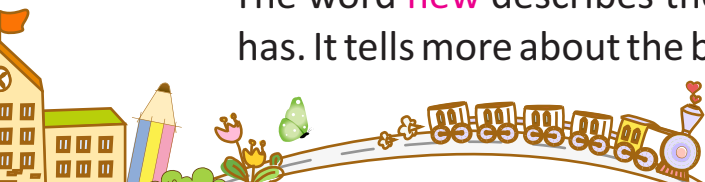
Read the following sentences.

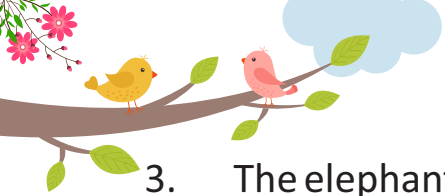
1. Anjan is a **tall** boy.

The word **tall** describes the kind of boy Anjan is. It tells more about the boy.

2. Rupali has a **new** purse.

The word **new** describes the kind of bag Rupali has. It tells more about the bag.

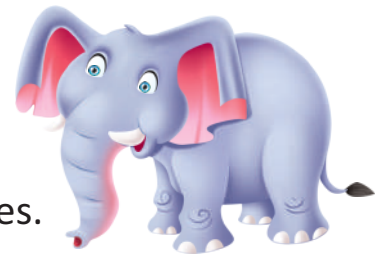




3. The elephant is a **big** animal.

The word **big** describes the kind of animal the elephant is. It tells more about the animal.

In the above sentences, the words **tall**, **new** and **big** are adjectives.



Grammar Byte

- Adjectives tell us about the colour, shapes or size : **red** balloon, **round** ball, **tall** animal, etc.
- They tell us how many there are : **three** kites, **four** balls, **five** balloons, etc.
- They tell us about some certain qualities : **intelligent** girl, **kind** woman, etc.

Now read the following sentences.

1. Sky is **blue**.



2. The ball is **round**.



3. The girl is **pretty**.



In the above sentences, **blue**, **round** and **pretty** are **adjectives**. They describe the **sky**, the **ball** and the **girl** respectively. They are therefore, adjectives. But they are placed after the nouns they describe.

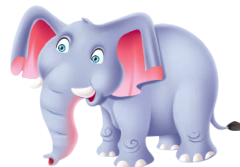

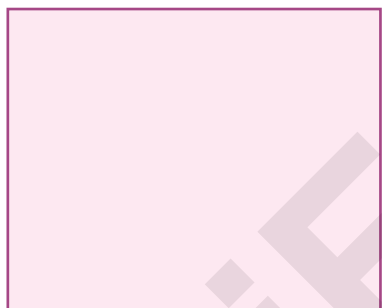
