A word that tells what a person, thing or animal does is called a **Verb**. They are called action words.

## Read the following sentences.

- The birds **fly** in the sky.  
**The word fly tells what the birds do.**
- Kajol **draws** a picture.  
**The word draws tells what Kajol does.**
- Neeraj **catches** a ball.  
**The word catches tells what Neeraj does.**





4. Rupali **sings** sweetly.

The word **sings** tells what Rupali does.

**Fly, draws, catches** and **sings** are action words.

They express an action. These words are called **verbs**.



## Grammar Byte

- ◉ The verbs *fly, draws, sings and catches* are made up of only one word. Sometimes, a verb can be made up of two or more than two words.

Now, read the following sentences.

1. I **am** a girl.
2. The tea **is** hot.
3. The mangoes **are** ripe.



The words **am, is** and **are** help to say what I am, the tea is, or the mangoes are.

They just say that people or things are something. They are also called **verbs**.



## Grammar Byte

- ◉ A verb is also used to say what a person, thing or animal does. They are called action verb.

Now, read the following sentences.

1. My uncle **has** a car.
2. The monkeys **have** long tails.
3. We **had** a big house last year.



The words **has, have** and **had** tell us what my uncle, the monkeys and we have or possess. These words are also known as **verbs**.

The verb is "**is eating**". The sentence is made up of two words **is** and **eating**.

The verb is "**are playing**". The sentence is made up of two words **are** and **playing**.



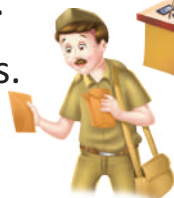
3. They **will be leaving** for Kolkata tomorrow.

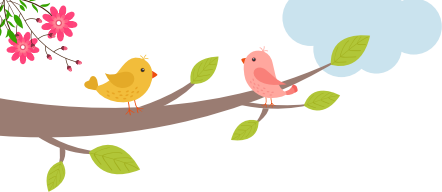
