


Simple Present Tense

Learning Outcomes

- Students will understand the structure and use of the simple present tense.
- They will learn to form positive, negative, and interrogative sentences in the simple present tense.
- They will use the simple present tense to describe habitual actions and general truths.



Verbs also tell us about the time when an action happens. This is known as the tense of the verb. The action can take place in the present, past or future. So verb has three tenses: present, past and future.

Read the following sentence.


- 1. We go to school every day.
- 2. She eats an apple daily.
- 3. The sun rises in the east.





In the above sentences, go, eats and rises are all verbs. They are all in simple present tense.









In simple present tense, we use the root form of verbs with the subjects.

But when the subject is in the third person singular number a s or es is used with the verbs.

• In the simple present tense, we talk about things which constantly happen or an action that we repeat regularly.

Use of the Simple Present Tense

Read the following sentence.

The simple present tense is used

To express a fact. 1.

Examples:

- The Sun rises in the east.
- Polar bears live in the Arctic.
- To refer to an action we repeat regularly as a habit or custom. 2.

Examples:

- I wake up early every day.
- She walks in the morning.
- 3. To talk about a state or condition.

Examples:

- Grandma is ill today.
- Ganga and Yamuna are twins.
