- 3. We are playing football.








In the above sentences, the coloured words are all verbs. These verbs are in the present continuous tense.

In the present continuous tense, we use is, am, are with the root form of the verb and add –ing: is going, am reading and are playing.











• Present continuous tense is used to talk about an action or event that is happening at the moment of speaking.
