There are some ways in which we form the simple past tense.


• By adding -d or -ed after the verb.

• By replacing the -y at the end of the verb with -ied.



Points to Remember

- We use the simple past tense to talk about things which happened in the past.
- We use the terms like yesterday, last week, last month, last night, last year, etc. with the simple past tense.
- Some verbs make their simple past tense by adding -d or -ed after the verb. **①**
- Some verbs make their simple past tense by replacing the -y at the end of the verb with -ied.
- Some verbs make their simple past tense by doubling the last letter of the verb and adding -ed.
- Some verbs form their simple past tense by adding -t at the end.
- Some verbs do not follow the above rules. Their past tense is formed differently.
