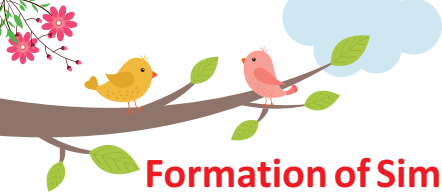
Simple Future Tense

Read these sentences.

1. I **shall buy** a book.

The verbs in these sentences are in the simple future tense.





Formation of Simple Future Tense

We use **shall/will** + root form of the verb.

shall buy **will visit** **will come**

Shall is used only with **I** and **we**.

Will can be used with all subjects.

We often use short forms also.

I shall - I'll

We will - We'll

They will - They'll

Use of the Simple Future Tense

We use the simple future tense of a verb to express an action that will take place in the time to come, in the future time. The tense is mostly used to give information about a future event.

I **shall become** a teacher when I grow up.

They **will play** the match next Sunday.

Words like tomorrow, next week, next month, etc., may be used to suggest the future time.
