

# **Story Writing**

#### **Learning Outcomes**

- They will develop characters, a setting, and a plot.

#### Tips to develop a story

- A good story has a clear plot which should be developed using the given outlines.
- No point in the given outlines should be omitted.
- Names can be given to the characters to make the story interesting.
- The story should be well-connected and logically developed. It should move on smoothly.
- The moral of the story should be stated in the end.
- Remember to give your story a title.
- It is better to use past tense while writing a story.
