#### Simple Future Tense

#### Read the following sentences.

- I **shall visit** my grandparents next Sunday.
- She will buy a new mobile tomorrow. 2.
- They will arrive here next week.





We use shall/will + root form of the verb.

shall invite, will meet, will arrive

shall is usually used with I and we.

will can be used with all subjects.

### . Use of the Simple Future Tense

The simple future tense is used to express an action that will take place in the time to come, in the future time.

**Example:** She will visit us next month.

This tense is used to give information about a future event.

#### **Examples:**

- 2. They will attend Roma's birthday tomorrow. We **shall meet** him tomorrow. 1.











• We often use words such as tomorrow, this week, next week, this month, next month and next year with the simple future tense.
