Simple Future Tense

Simple Future Tense

Read the following sentences.

- I **shall visit** my grandparents next Sunday.
- She **will buy** a new mobile tomorrow.
- They **will arrive** here next week.



In the above sentences, the verbs **shall visit**, **will buy** and **will arrive** are in the **simple future tense**.

Formation of the Simple Future Tense

We use **shall/will + root** form of the verb.

shall invite, will meet, will arrive

shall is usually used with **I** and **we**.

will can be used with all subjects.

Use of the Simple Future Tense

The **simple future tense** is used to express an action that will take place in the time to come, in the future time.

Example : She **will visit** us next month.

This tense is used to give information about a future event.

Examples :

- We **shall meet** him tomorrow.
- They **will attend** Roma's birthday tomorrow.

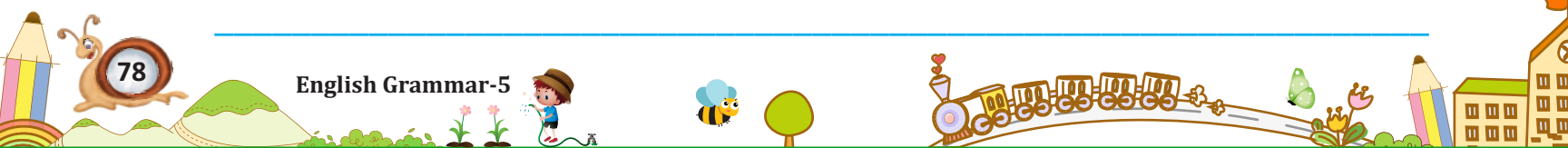

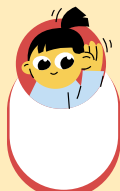
