Subject - Verb Agreement

In a sentence, a verb must agree with its subject. It is called **Subject-Verb** agreement.











- A singular noun takes a singular verb with it; a plural noun takes a plural verb with it.
- A singular pronoun takes a singular verb with it; a plural pronoun takes a plural verb with it.
- With the pronoun **you**, we always use a plural verb.

Some Examples of Subject-Verb Agreement

Singular	Plural
----------	--------

- 1. My pen is red. Your pens are blue.
- 2. The girl was happy. The girls were happy.
- 3. An elephant has a short tail. Elephants have short tails.
- 4. The dog barks. The dogs bark.
