Synonyms

A **synonym** is a word that is similar in meaning to other word. Here is a list of synonyms.

Word	Synonym	Word	Synonym
assistance	help	kind	generous
answer	reply	join	unite
amazing	wonderful	hollow	empty
allow	permit	haste	hurry
admire	praise	hard	difficult

Antonyms

An antonym is a word which is opposite or contrary in meaning to the other word. Here is a list of **antonyms**.

Word	Antonyms	Word	Antonyms
high	low	love	hate
different	same	little	much
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justice	injustice	smile	frown
sell	purchase	bless	curse
benefit	loss	often	seldom
absent	present	great	small
above	below	accept	reject

Suffix

A Suffix is a letter or set of letters that is added to the end of a word. It alters the meaning of the word.

Suffix -ly

Examples:

- month -monthly
- accidental accidentally
- brisk briskly

Suffix -ful

Examples:

- thank thankful
- harm harmful
- truth truthful

Suffix -less

Examples:

- worth worthless
- care careless
- taste tasteless
