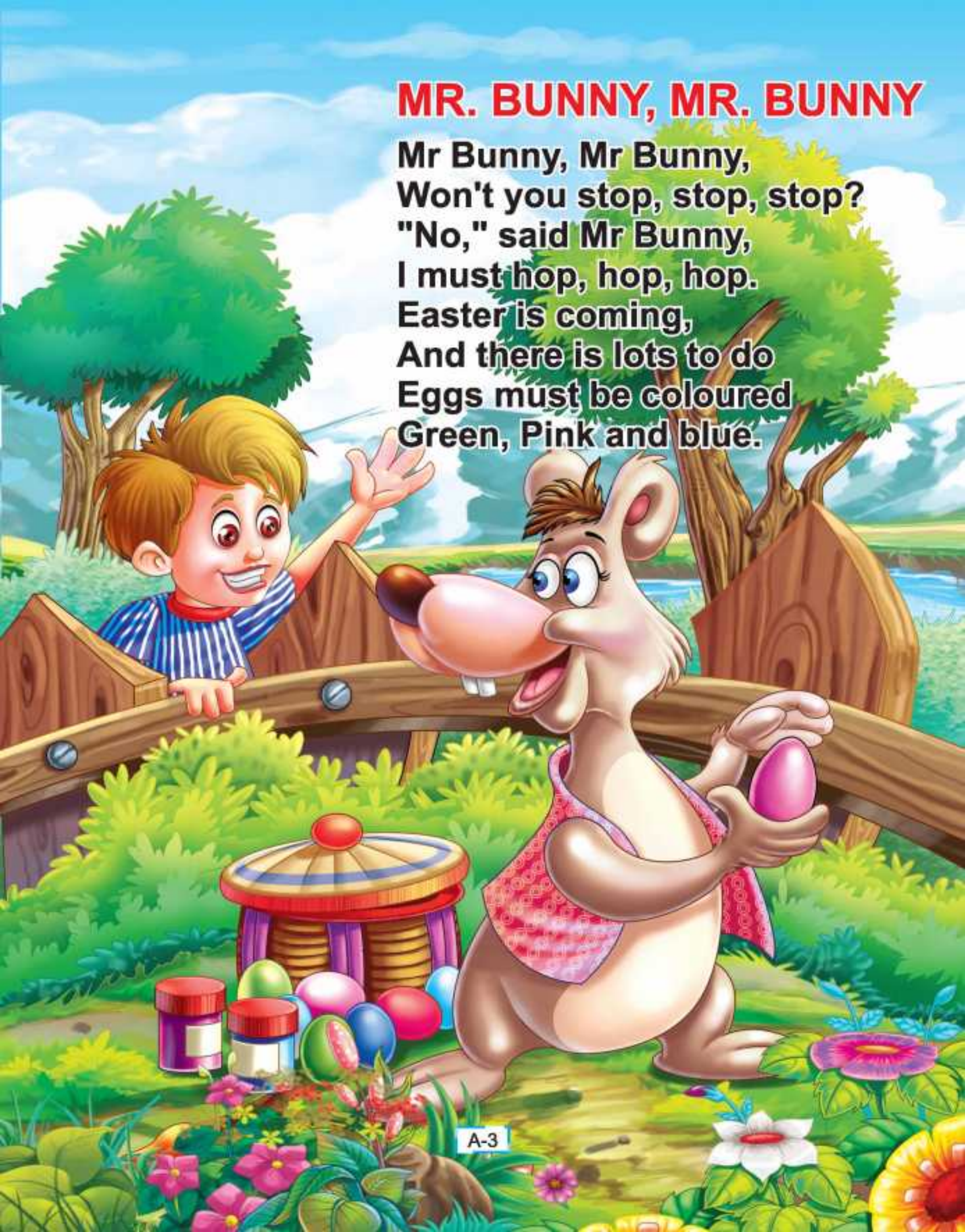


TWINKLE, TWINKLE, LITTLE STAR

Green, Pink and blue.

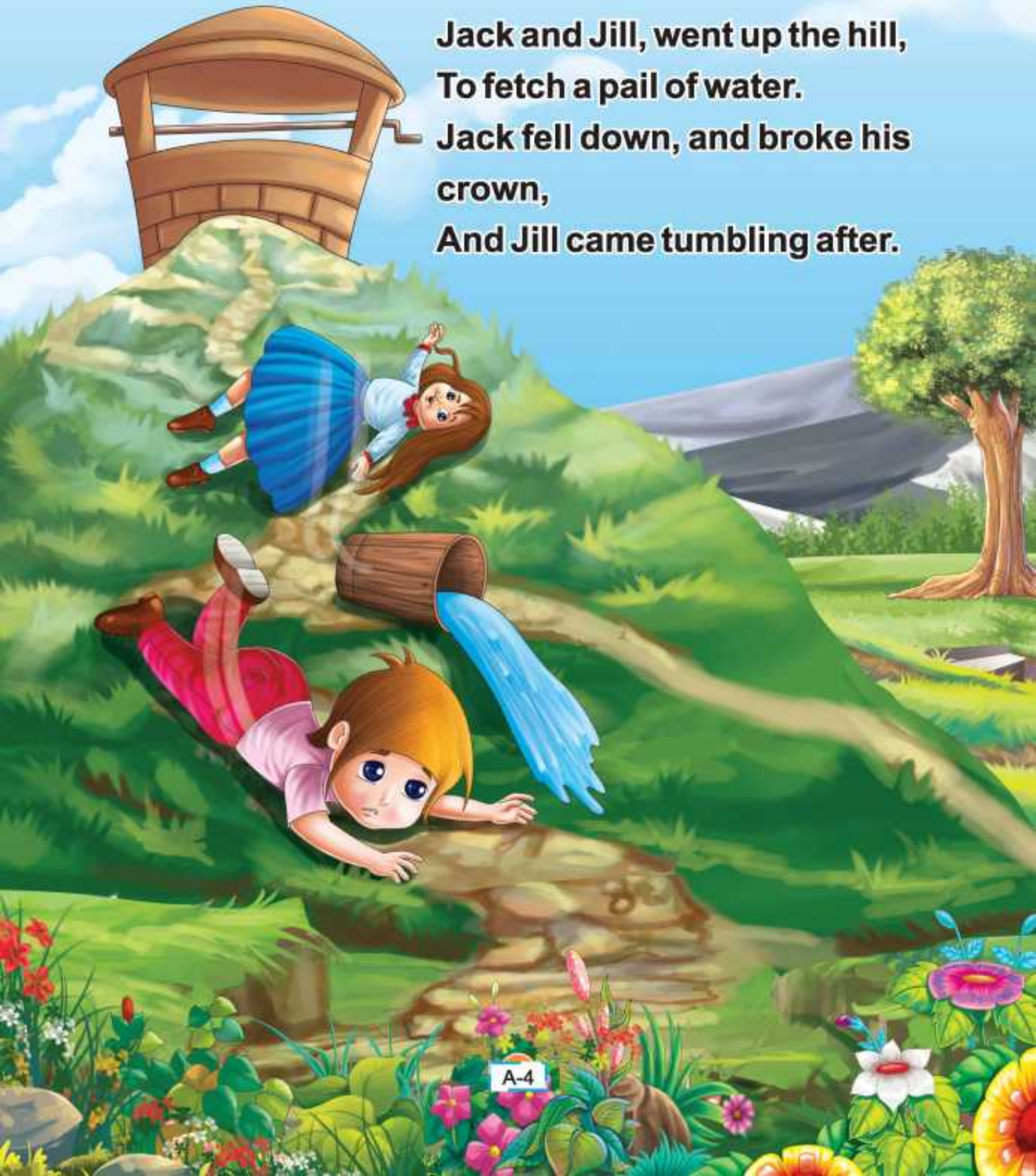


Jack And Jill

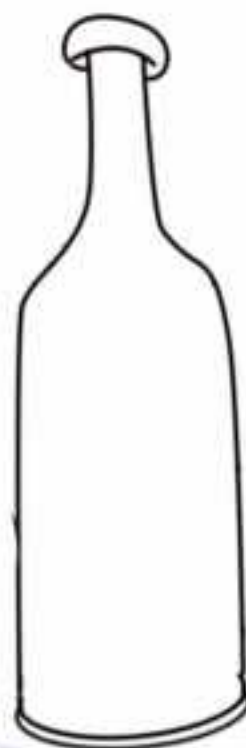
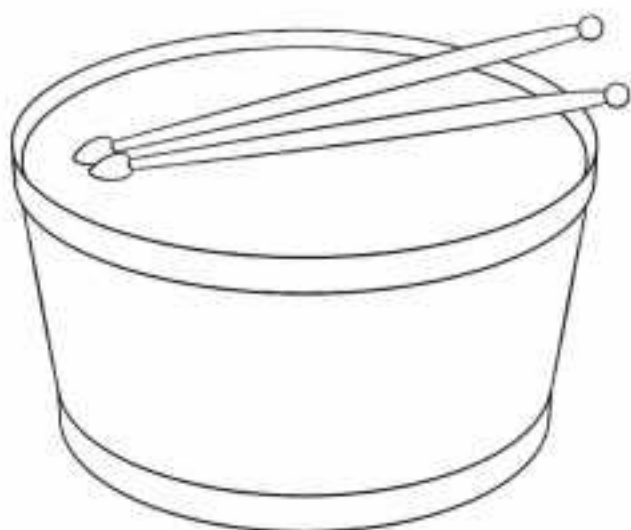
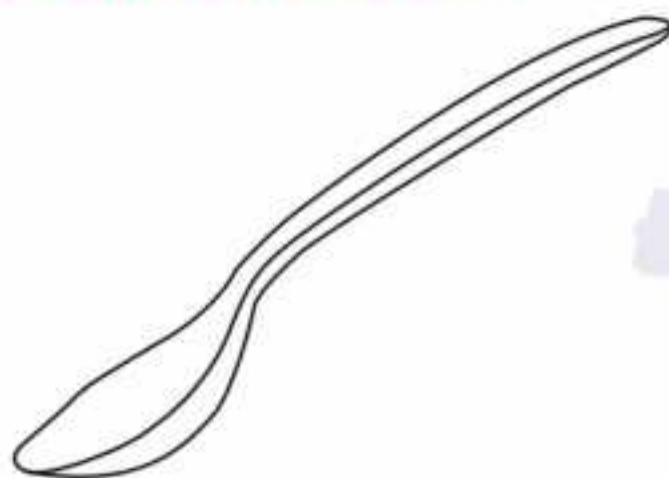
Jack and Jill, went up the hill,

And Jill came tumbling after.

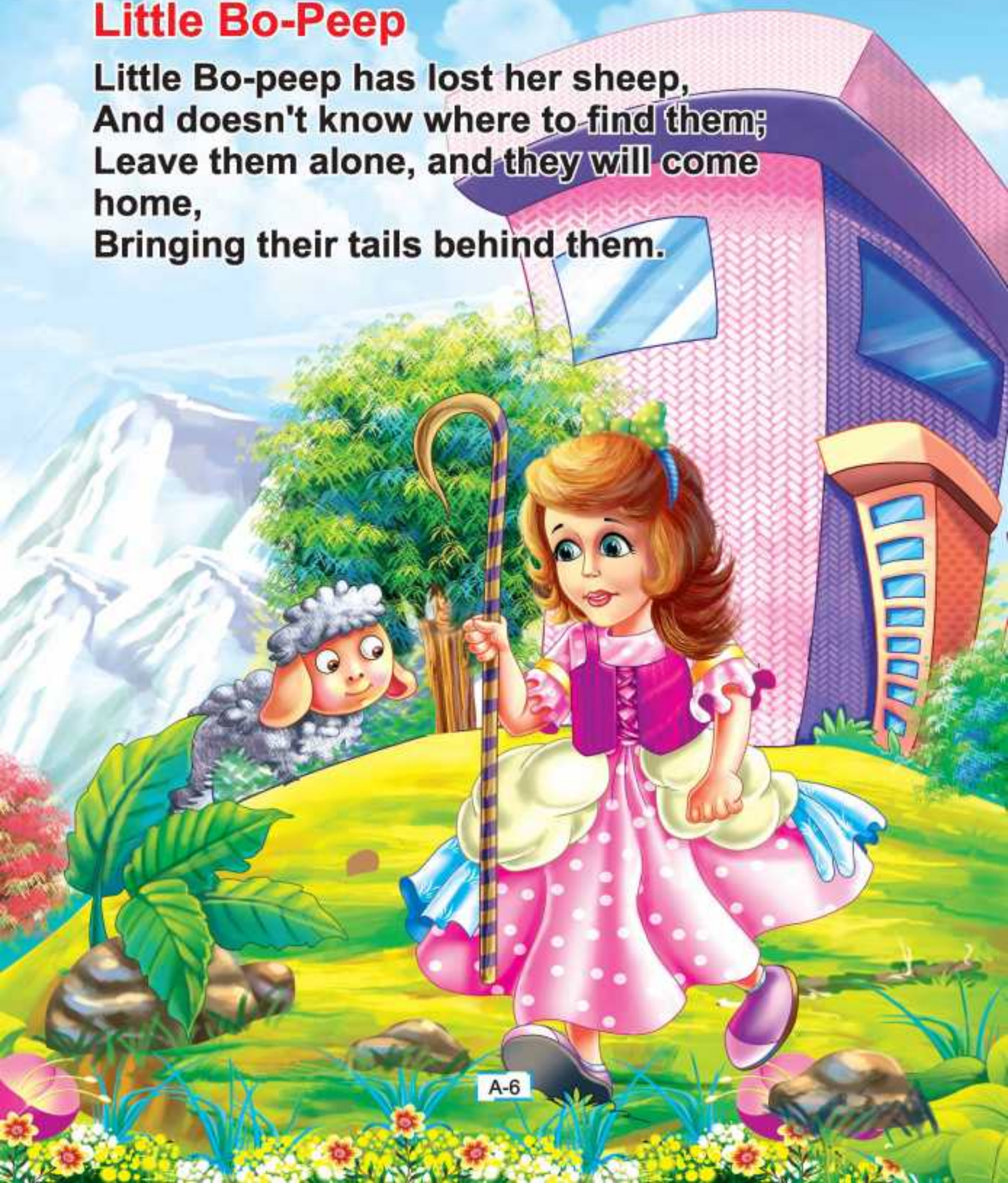


Colour the things in which we can store water.

make a fist.



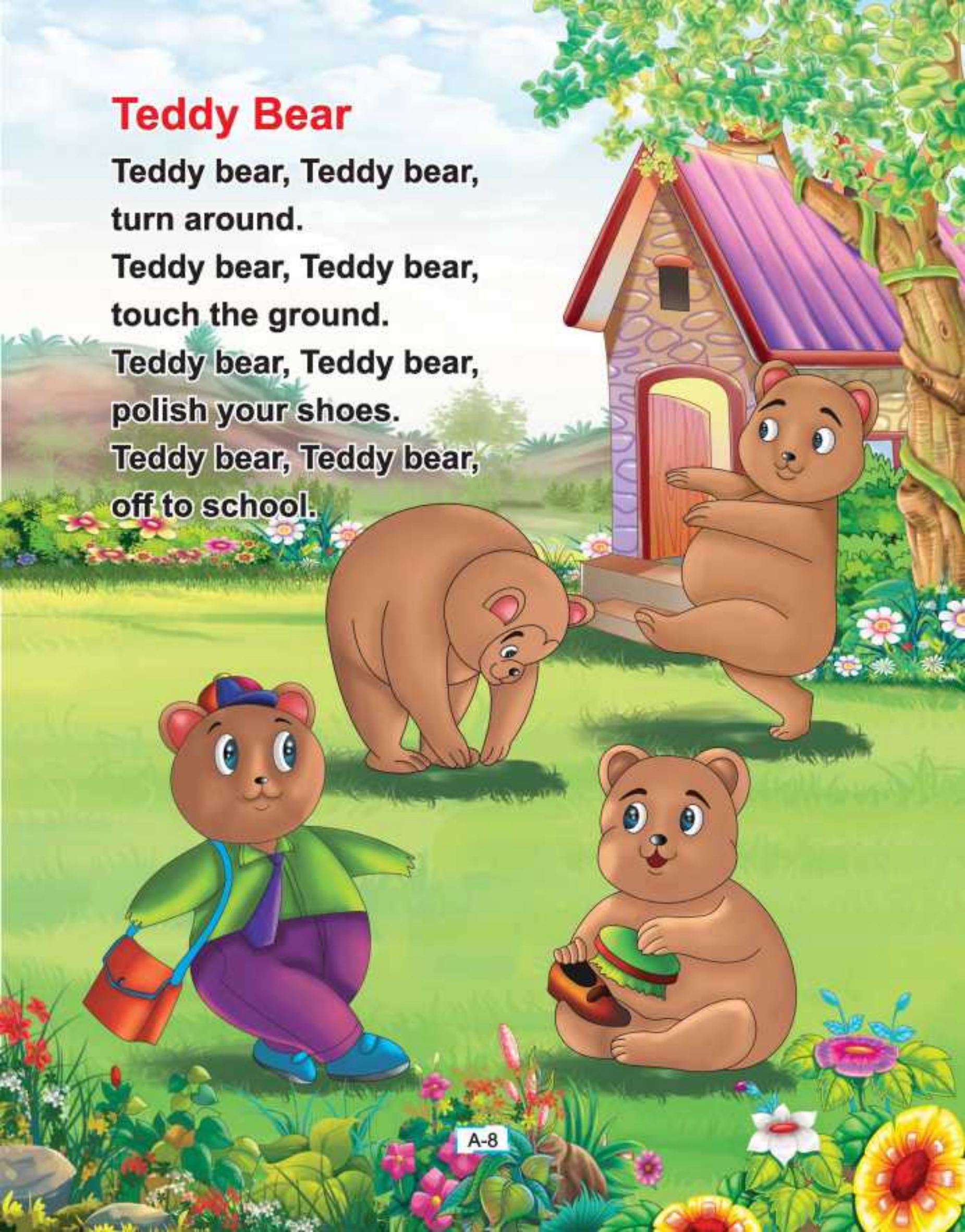
Teddy Bear

off to school.

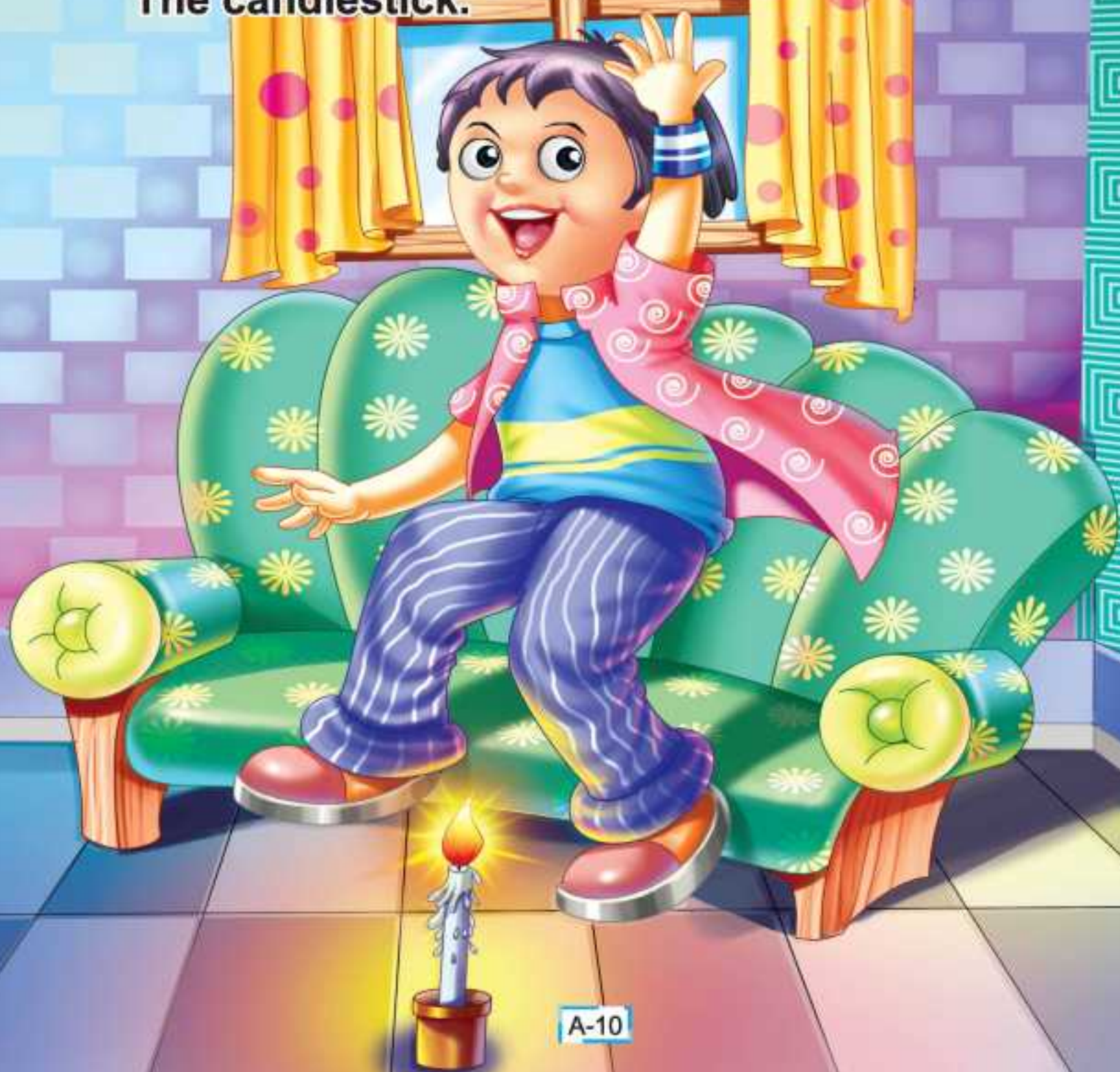

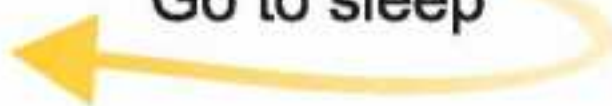

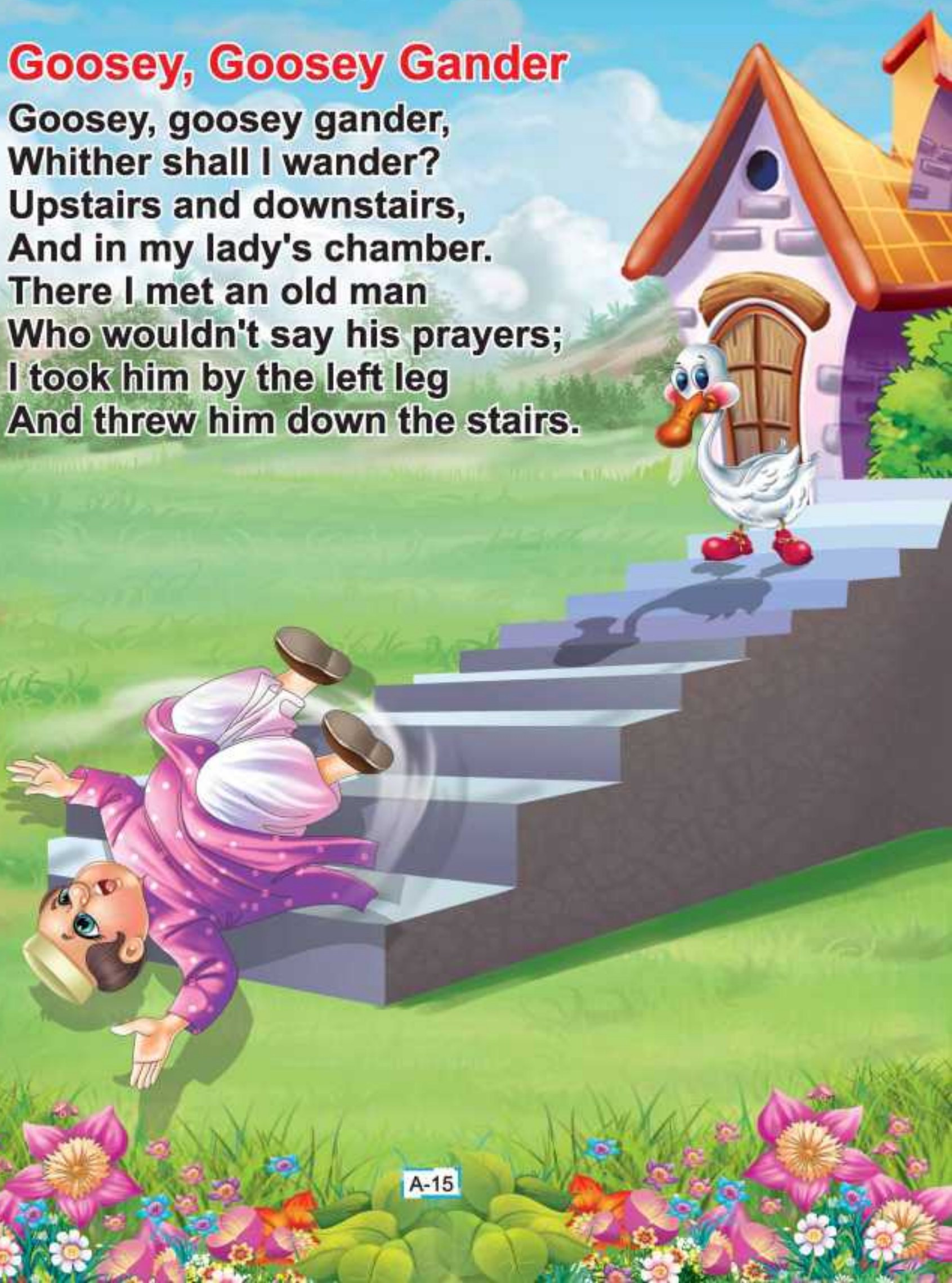

And sugar horses painted red.



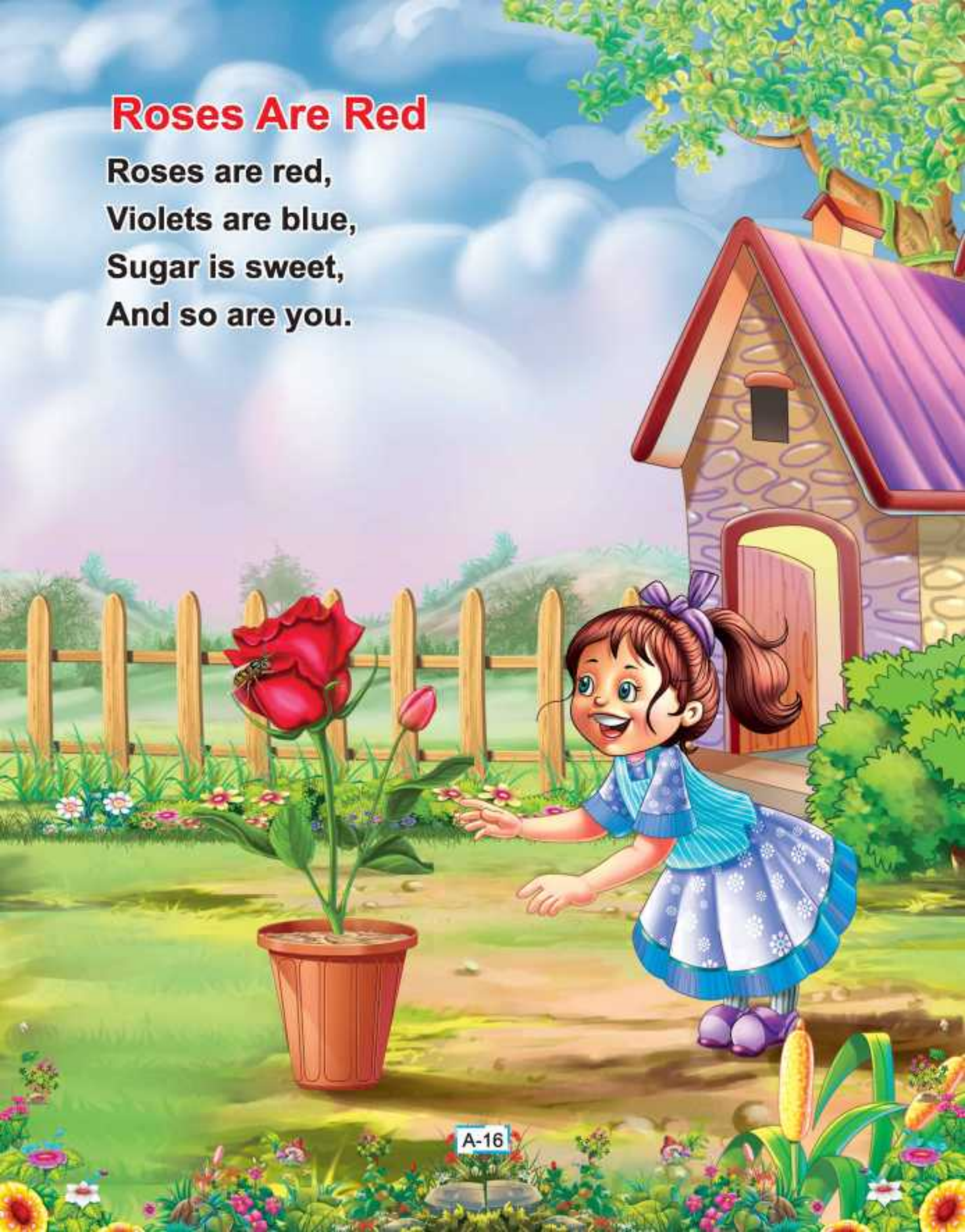
Goosey, Goosey Gander

And threw him down the stairs.**

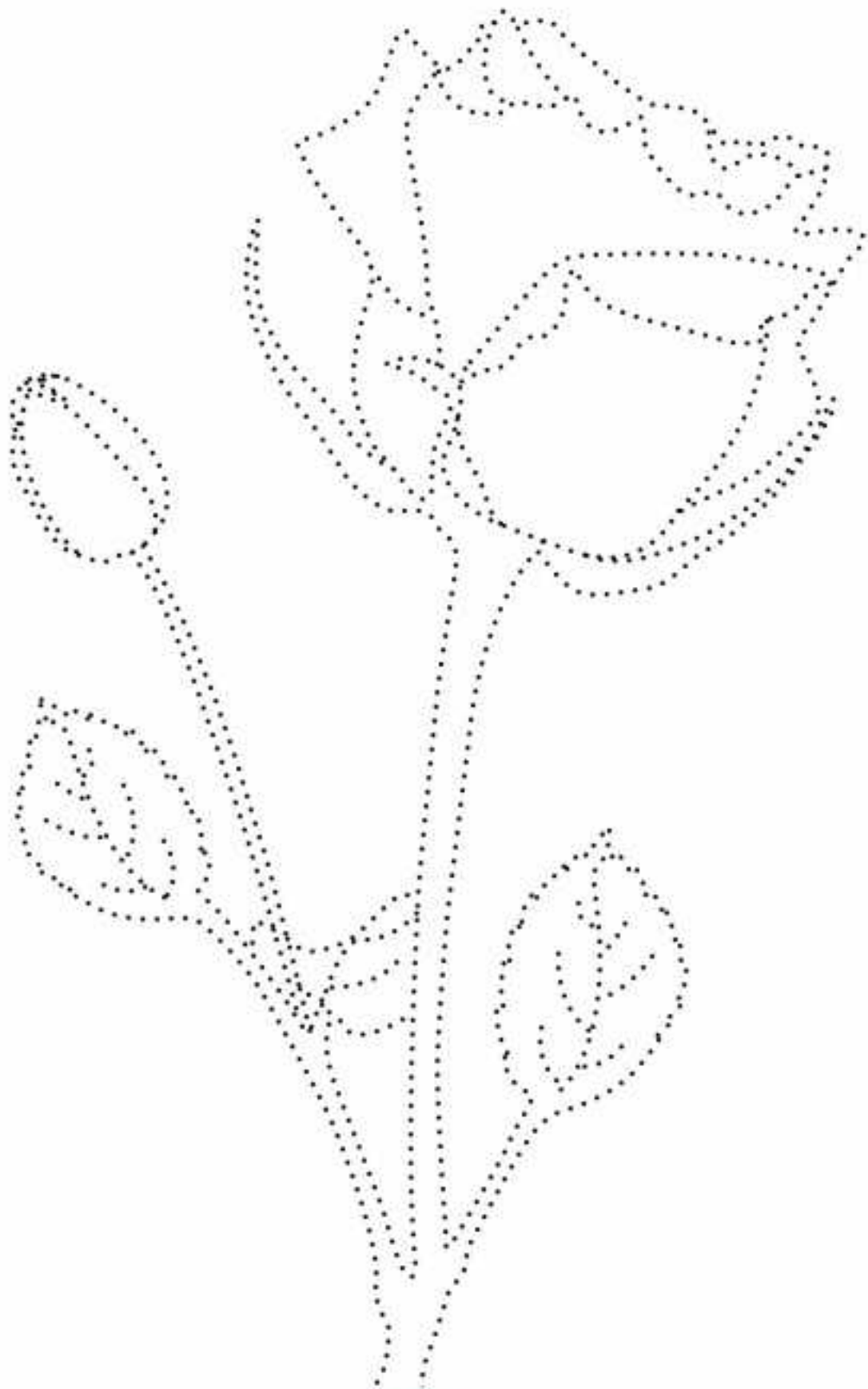


Roses Are Red

fall on the tree.

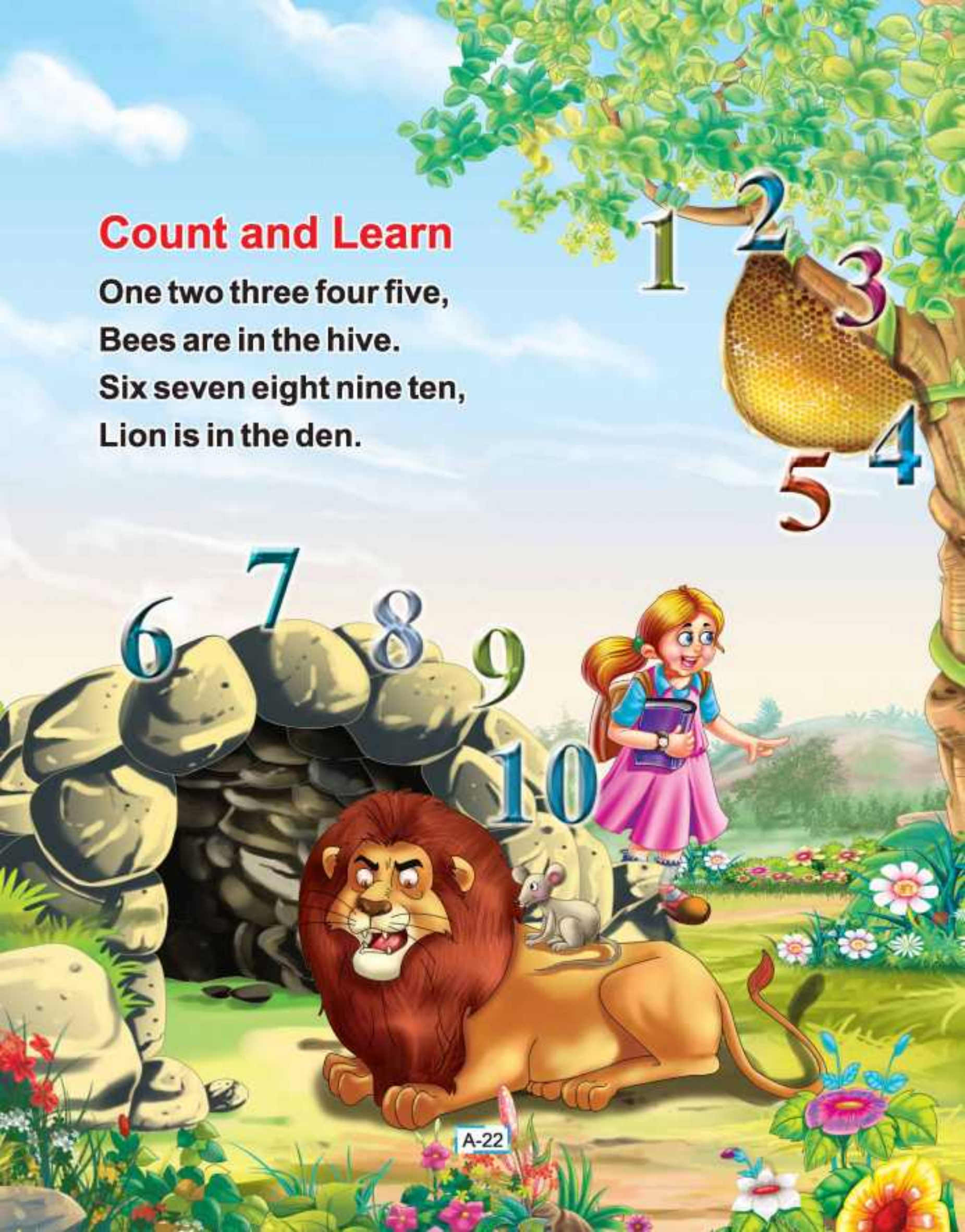
Tiny little rain drops,
