And said, "What a good boy am I!"




CAKE SO GOOD




MY RED BALLOON

head, head, head!


GIRL AND QUEEN



It is a golden rule.




Gogi

her very well.




FOR IT IS A PLEASING DAY

Come with happy faces all.




THE MICE

And I will be a very big man.





THE CROOKED MAN


There was a crooked man,

And sent them out of town.




