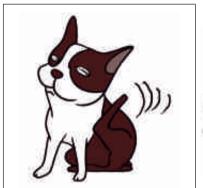


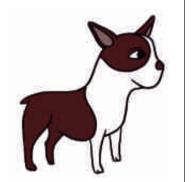
Emotions-Feelings

Even people with little experience with dogs can tell what a dog is most likely feeling.



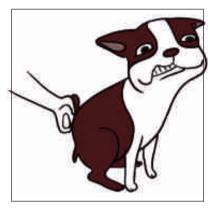
